The Zero Course prepares in Phonology, syntax, morphology basics, alphabetical sound usage, punctuation, dictation with punctuation, general common knowledge clerical tools, structured grammar, sound recognition sound-syllable division of words, hyphenation, word building, household vocabulary, simple past, present and future, usage of person, number and gender. Subject, predicate, verb analysis; article usage, ICA, IVA, DA and zero article; comparisons with Spanish for translation purposes. Tenses, verb analysis, comparison between link verb TO BE and action verb overall knowledge, infinitive forms, participle placing. Affirmative, negative, interrogative, negative-interrogative, imperatives, use of "please", question words and open-closed question creation and answering. Numbers, arithmetic, algebraic concepts, simple around-the-house conversations, 8 parts of speech, subject complement, adjective patterns, adverb patterns. Strategic reading: finding the core of a reading, the interpreting the message of the core, separation of basic, complementary and secondary information. Composition basics: Introduction, development, climax and epilogue. Early American history fiction tale and story telling. Listening exercises, the family, family ties family extensions. Listening. El Zorro. How Don Diego de la Vega becomes Zorro the fox. Overall usage of conversation around formulation of simple sentences.
